ISO 21542:2021 – Accessibility Visual Cheat Sheet (All Users)

Legend / Icons

-  Wheelchair / Mobility Impairments
-  Blind / Low Vision
-  Deaf / Hard of Hearing
-  Cognitive / Learning Disabilities





Entrances & Routes

Building entrance with ramp and doors.

-  Ramp slope $\leq 1:12$, non-slip, handrails both sides
-  Corridor width ≥ 1200 mm (≥ 1500 mm for two-way)
-  Detectable tactile paths to entrances and corridors
-  Clear sightlines to signs for visual access
-  Simple, predictable layout with minimal obstacles

2 Doors & Openings







Door with handle and signage.

-  Clear width ≥ 800 – 900 mm
-  Tactile & Braille signage, high contrast
-  Visual signals for automatic doors
-  Easy-to-use handles, clear pictograms







Vertical Circulation (Stairs & Elevators)

Elevator and stair side by side.

-  Elevator $\geq 1100 \times 1400$ mm, controls ≤ 1200 mm, turning space
-  Tactile floor indicators, auditory announcements
-  Visual floor indicators and alarms
-  Simple signage and consistent operation
-  Stairs: handrails both sides, ≥ 1200 mm width, contrasting nosings
-  Detectable warning strips at stair edges




Sanitary Facilities

Accessible toilet with grab bars.

-  Toilet $\geq 1500 \times 1500$ mm, grab bars, maneuvering space
-  Tactile door signs, Braille
-  Visual emergency alarms
-  Clear pictograms and simple instructions



Signage & Wayfinding

Wall with directional signs.

-  Tactile, Braille, high-contrast signs
-  Visual alarms for hearing impaired
-  Symbols simple and clear, minimal clutter

Emergency & Evacuation

Evacuation route with refuge area.

-  Refuge areas for wheelchair users
-  Tactile routes to exits



- 🗣️ Visual alarms for deaf users, auditory alarms for hearing users
- 🧠 Clear instructions and simple maps

7 External Areas

Pathway with parking and public transport access.

- ♿ Accessible paths, parking, drop-offs
- 👁️ Tactile guide paths, detectable edges
- 🗣️ Visual cues and clear sightlines
- 🧠 Predictable and consistent layout
